Tom Asklar, local artist and Edmund Fitzgerald enthusiast, hosts a Tribute to the Edmund Fitzgerald, an American Great Lakes freighter that sank during a storm on Lake Superior.

The SS Edmund Fitzgerald, also known as the "Mighty Fitz", went down on November 10 1975, with the loss of the entire crew of 29.

The evening begins promptly at 7pm with:

- **A Multi-media presentation** covering the ship's history, **timeline** of the tragedy, and **theories of its destruction**
- **Tolling of the bell** will honor the souls of the crew
- **Music** with a nautical theme, including Gordon Lightfoot's musical tribute "*The Wreck of the Edmund Fitzgerald*"
- Don't miss the **Edmund Fitzgerald sculpture**, created by Justin Higner, which will be on display throughout the evening
- "**Edmund Fitzgerald Porter**", made by Great Lakes Brewery, will be on tap all night
- **Prizes and give-aways** will add to the fun
