Festival Information

- The show is held outdoors on Center Street in the Village of Lewiston.
- Center Street will be closed to vehicular traffic.
- **Street Musicians/Buskers must be pre-registered.**
- When you arrive, go to the Information Booth at 5th & Center to be given your spot assignment and permit.

We do have a few rules we insist our performers abide by:

- All entertainers must fill out the Busker Application Form and be accepted by the LCA
- Performers must display their permit and perform in the spot to which they were assigned
- No electrical amplification is permitted
- Performances should always be appropriate for a family based audience
- CD's may be sold but no other merchandise. Performers may put out a hat or cast to collect money but may not verbally ask the public for money
- Performers under 18 must have the approval of their legal guardian. Performers under 16 should be accompanied by a responsible adult
- At all times, performers must conduct themselves in a manner that is courteous to other entertainers, vendors and public and be open to feedback from the LCA and its vendors. Remember that you are a welcomed guest and we do appreciate your contribution to the Lewiston Art Festival but we must ensure the comfort of our artists, customers and vendors alike
